Conflict Minerals

The protection of life, environment and nature are essential elements of our social system and their value and protection are of the greatest importance to us. We are aware of our responsibility; we support the worldwide endeavor to protect the environment and these basic rights will achieve highest respect, globally.

As a manufacturer of electronic sensors and electronic control units for automation, we are not an importer of raw materials such as minerals and metals. Therefore, and also due to the size of our company, we are not obliged to report on "conflict minerals".

The reporting obligation has been shifted to the smelters and refineries, an implemented requirement that the ZVEI (Zentralverband der Elektroindustrie) has been pursuing for years.

We purchase our electronic components from well-known manufacturers and distributors and guarantee traceability through our certified management system according to DIN ISO 9001. As a matter of principle, only the smallest amounts, if any, of tungsten, tantalum, tin or gold can be present in these elements. Thus far below the limits of Regulation (EU) 2017/821 Annex 1. According to our knowledge there are no conflict minerals in our products.
